What is STRIVE?

The Support for Transgender and Nonbinary Individuals Seeking Vaginoplasty (STRIVE) Study aims to learn how to better support transgender and nonbinary individuals as they prepare for vaginoplasty.

How does STRIVE work?

Study participants are randomly assigned to receive the STRIVE intervention OR the usual pre-operative care provided by their care team, enhanced by STRIVE's robust educational materials.

Participants are then asked to complete up to 6 surveys about their health and wellbeing for up to 24-months after enrollment in STRIVE. Participants can be paid up to \$255 for completing these surveys.

What is the STRIVE intervention?

The intervention is a series of six online group support and education sessions provided by trans peer-support specialists trained in collaboration with Trans Lifeline.
